## Session Qualifications

### Early Figure Skating Academy

Entrance to the Early Figure Skating Academy is by invitation or audition. Learn more [www.skatecoquitlam.com](http://www.skatecoquitlam.com). The program teaches young skaters skating skills in a figure skating environment. Divided into three levels, skaters learn skating fundamentals, including edges, turns, stops, spins and jumps. Instructed entirely by our NCCP certified professional coaches, skaters will receive both group lessons and individual attention during practice time. Upon completion of the third level of the program, skaters will be able to spin in two different positions, perform at least two single rotation jumps and be ready to enter the Skate Canada STARSkate Program, if they haven't already started. **Early Figure Skating Academy participants up to and including Stage 5 must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet while on the ice. Bicycle helmets are not permitted.**

### Junior

These sessions are for skaters in the Early Figure Skating Academy program and those working on their first free skate, skills, and dance tests (Preliminary level), except where indicated (see registration form for details). The session cost is for ice only. Skaters must arrange lessons with the professional coach of their choice prior to booking ice with the club. ### Intermediate

Skaters on these sessions must have passed their Junior Bronze Freeskate.

### Senior

Skaters on these sessions must have passed their Pre-Novice / Senior Silver Freeskate.

### Junior Dance

Preliminary to Junior Silver Dance Level.

### Senior Dance

Senior Silver Dance to Diamond Dance Level.

### Open Dance

For skaters of all levels of Dance.

**Note- Sessions that do not have sufficient registration numbers are subject to cancellation. Skaters must skate on the sessions for which they qualify.**
