The Program

CanSkate is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program geared to school aged children that teaches fundamental movements (go forward, go backward, stop, turn, spin and jump) and basic skills. The program is set up in seven stages. The CanSkate program emphasizes fun and continuous movement and is taught in a group lesson format: **CanSkate is taught ENTIRELY by professional NCCP certified Skate Canada professional coaches** and assisted by trained Program Assistants. Awards and incentives are used to motivate skaters to achieve and develop their skills as well as to keep interest high! CanSkate is a feeder program to all other Skate Canada programs.

CanSkate FAQ

Do you take 3 Year Olds?

Yes, we will take three year olds, but they must be capable of receiving group instruction for 45 minutes and able to be on the ice without a parent. Most of the three year olds in our program have had some previous ice experiences (i.e. if they fall down they can get up by themselves).

Do you teach all levels on all sessions?

Yes, all levels are offered on all sessions for all ages.

Do you have equipment rentals?

No, skaters must supply their own skates and helmet. Helmets are mandatory for all skaters.

How many days should we skate?

For optimum development, we recommend twice a week. Skating is a sport where skills are learned by feel and continuous repetition. The more times a skater can repeat a skill in a week, the faster they will progress.

How do refunds work?

The Coquitlam SC does not offer refunds except in the case of medical circumstances. You must miss a minimum number of 5 consecutive, registered skating days to qualify. A doctor's certificate must be included with your written request for a refund. Medical refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the Board of Directors. If granted, the refund will be pro-rated from the date of the medical documentation.
